Skill Up Tennessee

Skill Up TN is the University of Tennessee Extension's SNAP Employment & Training (SNAP E&T) program. This is available to residents in all 95 counties across the state of Tennessee. Here are the three qualifications for a person to be eligible to participate in the Skill Up TN program:

1. They must be receiving SNAP benefits (formerly known as food stamps). They do not have to be the head of household on the case but would have to at least be listed as an active household member on someone SNAP case with the Department of Human Services (DHS).
2. They cannot be receiving TANF (families first cash assistance).
3. They must be willing and able to work.

The goal of SNAP Employment & Training is to assist adults with obtaining the skills, training, or education needed to obtain employment for careers that are in demand.

3. Have a barrier to employment, including but not limited to, low income, have child(ren) or are pregnant, or have a disability.
